



## **Canteen useful information**

Parents can 'top-up' their child's account using the ParentMail system

You can send your child with cash to 'top-up', the machine is located in the main corridor

If a student owes more than £4.00 the following rules will apply:

- At lunchtime, they will be able to have a sandwich or a small pasta pot but no additional items such as bottled drinks. There is always free filtered water available
- Students will not be able to borrow more money
- The canteen staff will not allow any further transactions without authorisation

### ***Please note the following information for all students:***

- Students on the outstanding lunch money list may not be allowed items such as bottled drinks
- We do not allow more than two biscuits at lunch-time
- Parents and Students are encouraged to check the lunch money balance regularly and 'top up' before break time, where possible
- If you are entitled to Free School Meals the daily limit is £2.30. Students occasionally go over this limit and arrangements should be made to clear any outstanding balances. The same £4.00 limit applies to students on Free School Meals.

If a parent/carer wishes to limit their child's daily spend, please contact the office and we will organise this for you.
