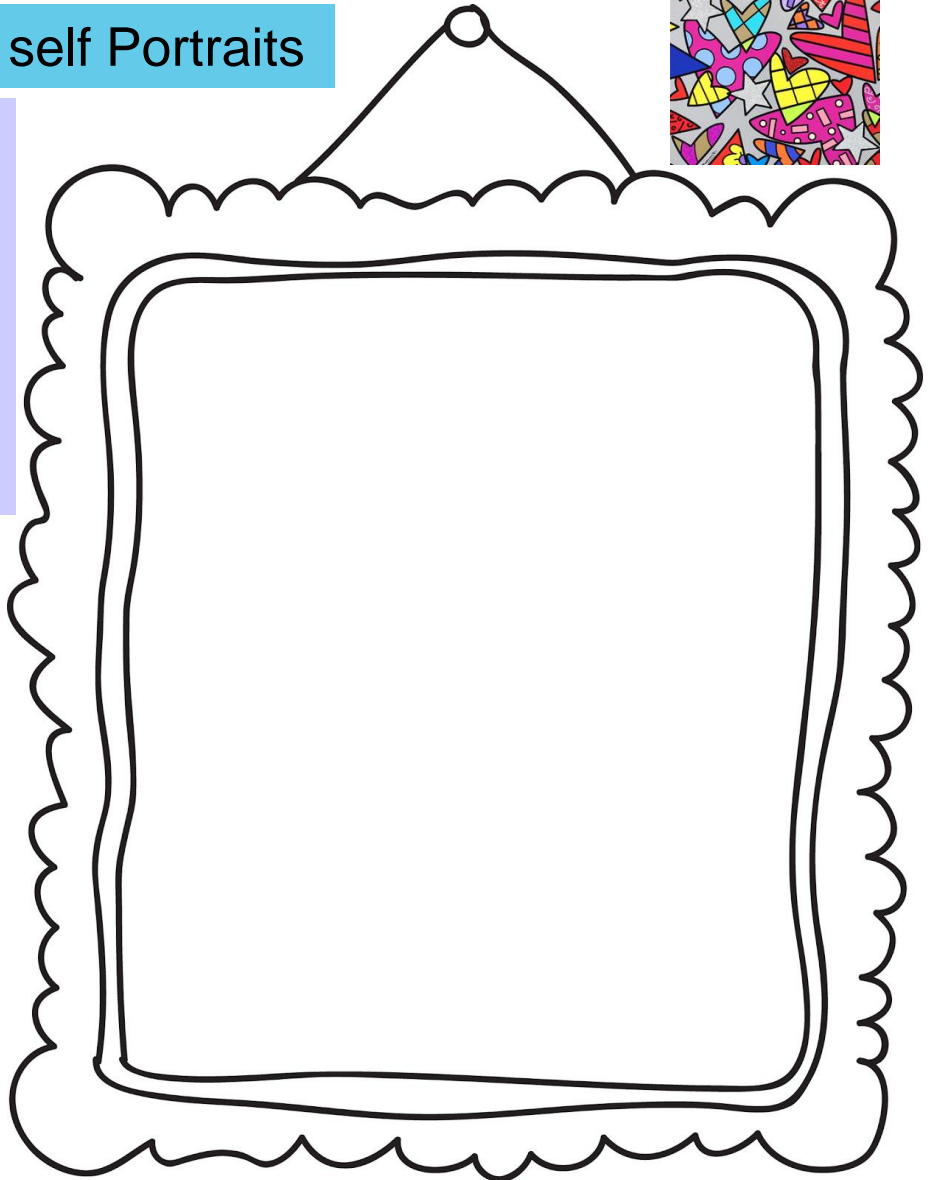
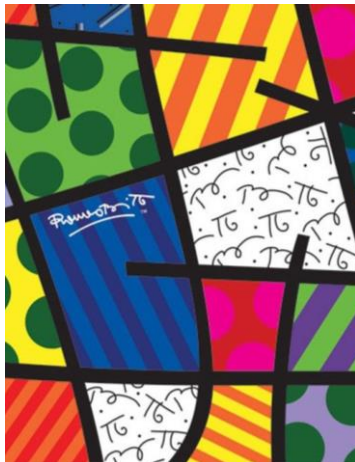


Hurworth School Art & Design Transition task
