Transition Days Arrangements

Hurworth School Transition days this year will be on Tuesday 5th and Wednesday 6th July 2022. The days will start from 10am and finish at 3pm to avoid congestion around the school premises.

During the day, students will follow a special timetable to ensure that they experience some fun lessons with our teachers, get to have a look around school, have their individual photos taken for our school information system and their thumb prints taken for our cashless catering systems. Please ensure that you have completed the data request forms and permissions, where required, so that this can go ahead smoothly. Where possible all forms should be returned to the school office before Transition takes place.

Students will have lunch at Hurworth in the dining hall. As they are not currently on our system, they will need to either bring a packed lunch or some money to buy their lunch (no more than £2.50 is needed each day).

During breaks and lunchtimes, they will be allowed to socialise with our current students for a short time and staff will be supervising to ensure they have a good time.

Depending on the information provided by your children on the Student Transition Form (included in pack), I will try to place them in their new form with some of their friends. For those students who will be the only student from their primary school coming to Hurworth, I usually try to put them together in a form with other single children to help them make new friendship groups and this usually works really well.

I will be in contact with primary schools about Transition and they should have any further information you need after May half term holidays.
